

AP Testing Update - April 2020

All of our students have been registered for the respective test(s) they want to take. Information about each test will be e-mailed directly to the students using the e-mail address that they used with the registration process.

Students will be taking the test online at home. At home testing procedures will be emailed to the students later in April. These directions will cover exactly what you need to do to take the test. There will also be notes for how to handle anything out of the ordinary that may occur on the day of the test. Shortly before the test, the student will receive an e-mail message with the appropriate credentials (a join code) to take the test.

The test will be a shortened version compared to prior years. It should take approximately 45 minutes. Students will be responsible for keeping track of the available time on their own. The test will automatically close out when the allotted time is up.

Students will also have a choice of typing their responses or handwriting their answers.

Students have the option to cancel their registration if they do not want to take the test in this manner. As the district is covering the cost of the tests, there will be no loss to the students if they decide not to take the test.

Colleges and universities have already agreed to accept the results of these tests as they have done in prior years.
