

The 2020-2021 Sixth Sense COVID-19 Safety Plans

Academic Competition Sixth Grade

Testing

Sixth Sense Testing will take place in the Fall. For the safety of the students and ourselves, testing will be completed online, instead of a paper and pencil test. Testing will take place in the sixth-grade classrooms at both S.S. Palmer and Towamensing Elementary Schools. All students, including virtual students, will have the opportunity to complete the test. After the tests are scored, a team of six students will be chosen.

Team Practices

Practices will take place in the S.S. Palmer Library after school on assigned days. Participants will be required to wear a mask and remain socially distanced (to the greatest extent possible) during team practices. The seating area, table, and competition buzzers will be cleaned by the advisors before and after practices. The Health and Safety Plan of S.S. Palmer Elementary School will be in effect, and complied with, at all practices.

Competition

If at any time, a student is not feeling well, or is diagnosed with COVID-19, that student will not be joining the team at the competition. If the competition takes place in-person, temperatures will be checked before leaving the school each morning and, if our team makes it to the finals, prior to the evening competition on the last day. Students will be social distancing (to the greatest extent possible) and required to wear a mask. If a student was in school prior to the competition and is diagnosed with COVID-19, both CDC and Department of Health recommendations will be followed.
