

Seniors - Good Afternoon.

On Monday, March 22, the Senior Class will be moving forward with ticket sales for the Class of 2021 Senior Prom. Tickets will be sold electronically.

The tickets will be sold online through our ticketing website. (Cash sales will only be allowed for extenuating circumstances.) If you receive permission to make a cash purchase, you will not officially have your tickets until the sale is finalized and processed by Mr. Borland. Tickets will be sold on a first come - first served basis. If you are unable to attend and want a refund of the purchase, please note that there will be a fee charged by the ticketing service.

The tickets are priced as follows per person: \$27.00 – Palmerton Senior / \$58.50 – All Other Guests

Ticket sales will follow this schedule:

Phase 1 (03/22 7:00 AM to 03/26 9:00 PM): Palmerton Seniors purchasing tickets for themselves and a PASHS senior student guest.

Phase 2 (03/29 7:00 AM to 04/02 9:00 PM): Guest tickets become available on a first come - first-served basis.

In the event a guest is unable to purchase a ticket because there are none remaining, a refund can be issued for your initial purchase. As noted, the transaction will be subject to a small fee.

We understand there may be concerns about selling out of tickets. This is why we are allowing our seniors to purchase their ticket before any guests. We do not want to limit the number of available tickets. Unfortunately, we do not have a choice. If the head count restrictions are eased and more seating becomes available, extra tickets may be offered. Please understand that this sales plan is the fairest option we could offer.

If you are a Palmerton Senior purchasing a ticket for your date who is also a Palmerton Senior please purchase your ticket first and then complete a separate order for your date's ticket. Please ensure "PATRON INFORMATION" is the information of the student the ticket is for.
