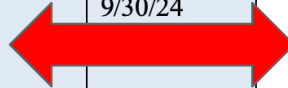

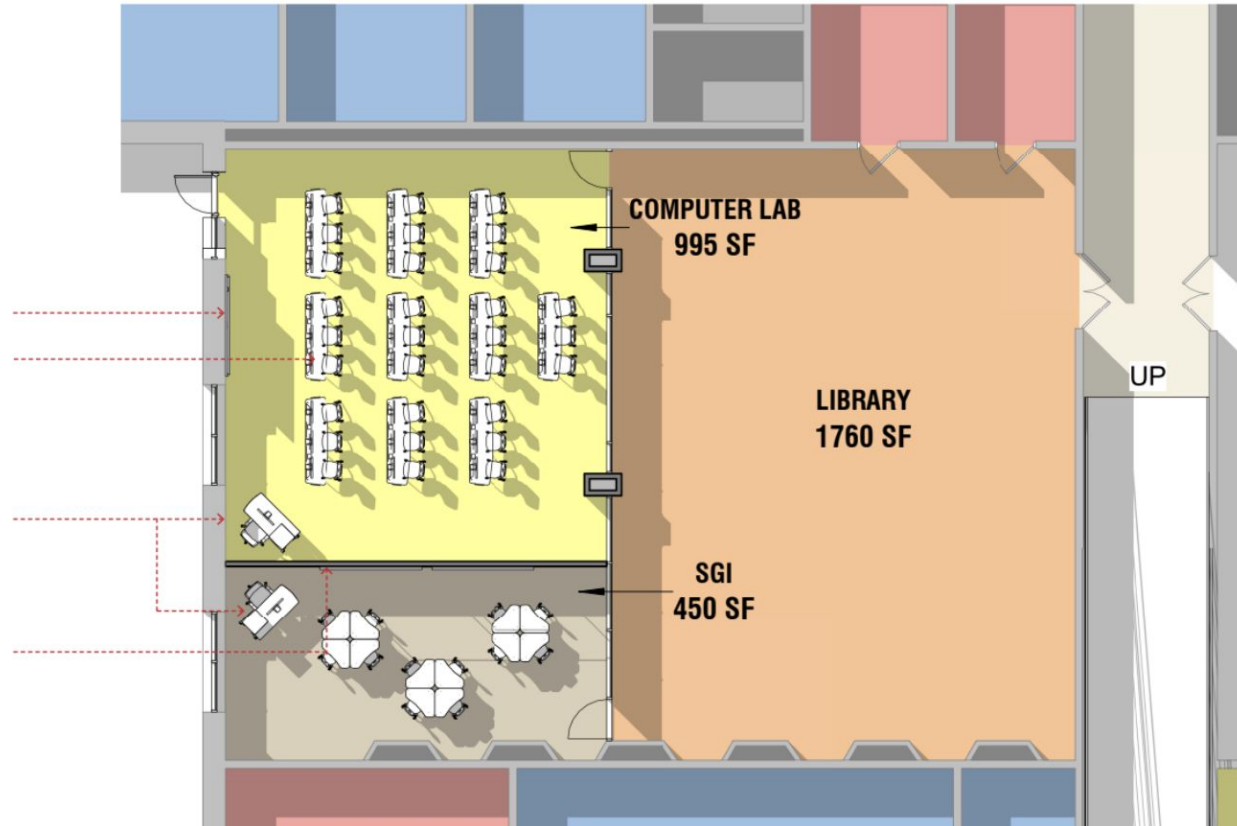
**Superintendent's Recommendations**
