

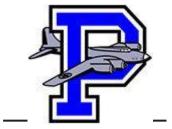

• Is the use of funds allowable, necessary, and reasonable?

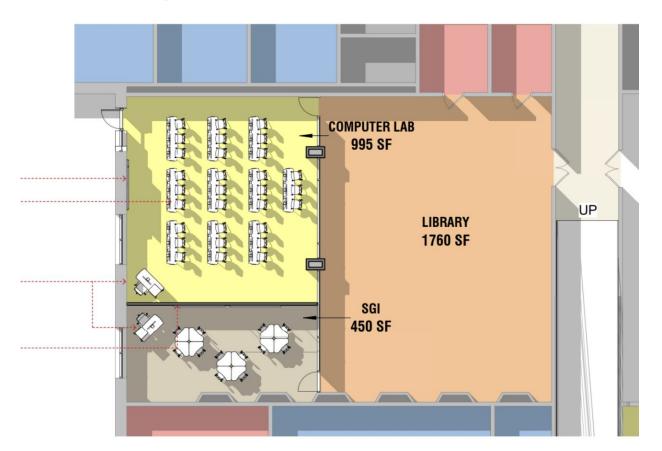
Superintendent's Recommendations

Building Substitutes and the Math Coach: These are temporary positions that will be eliminated at the end of the 22-23 school year.

Guidance Counselor & Social Worker: These positions should remain after the end of the ESSER grant funds. They should be included in the district's general operating budget.
