



Director of Special Education

The Palmerton Area School District is accepting applications for the position of Director of Special Education. This position is responsible for planning, administering, and supervising the district's special education program in accordance with state and federal regulations and laws. Applicants should be knowledgeable of best practices and be able to provide leadership and supervision to meet the special education needs of the district. This position is also responsible for serving as the district's homeless liaison and for overseeing home education and English Learner (EL) programming.

Candidates must have strong communication and interpersonal skills.

Applicants must possess either a current Pennsylvania PK-12 Supervisor of Special Education certification or PK-12 Principal certification along with a Master's Degree and prior experience teaching special education or a related field. Prior administrative experience is preferred.

Salary Range is \$95,000 – 100,000 and is commensurate with experience.

Applicants must submit a signed cover letter, resume, PA Standard Application, copy of valid PA certification, transcripts, current clearances, and 3 letters of recommendation.
